I'm a teaching artist trained and experienced in acting, playwriting, directing, singing, dancing, music, mindfulness curriculum, arts education, and managing city and state grants.

Teaching Arts Experience

Teaching Artist and Director at Talent Unlimited High School; NYC, NY

I direct this annual after-school program at Talent Unlimited High School in Manhattan, and also lead lessons and direct scenes. After four months of rehearsals, it culminates in a final scene-night performance on the Broadway stage at Circle in the Square, which I also host/narrate. I started in 2018 when I filled in for another director, and took over in 2019 when he moved and asked me to take on his position directing this program. In 2018, we worked on a mixture of Molière and Shakespeare; while in 2019 on, we've focused solely on Shakespeare.

Director of Arts Education at Circle in the Square Theatre School; NYC, NY 2017-Present

In March of 2017 I was hired to direct the Arts Education for Actors annual training program for Circle alumni. I organize and schedule all workshops, conferences, a playwriting residency at PS 11, and all PS 11 performances on our Broadway stage. I lead a new team of Circle alumni trainees each year.

Master Teaching Artist at Circle in the Square's residency at PS 11; NYC, NY 2014-Present

I began teaching Daniel Judah Sklar's technique of playwriting called PLAYMAKING in 2014. I work with Circle in the Square in residency at Manhattan's PS 11 teaching all third-grade classes how to write their own scripts. Additionally, I guide a team of residency assistants (RAs), who are also Circle in the Square Theatre School alumni, and teach them how to be teaching artists. When the kids finish their scripts, we direct and perform their plays on the Broadway stage at Circle in the Square. This is a six-month process each year, from the planning meetings and residency at PS 11, to rehearsals, performances, and assessment meetings. I continue this work with the following responsibilities:

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- Teach all classes
- Schedule and organize the residency team
- Create all lesson plans
- Teach and coach new Circle Residency Assistants (RAs)

Teaching Artist at PS 96, the Joseph Lanzetta School; NYC, NY

- Plan and lead RA Orientation meetings
- I taught two of the 4th grade classes at PS 96 in East Harlem. They wanted pre-show engagement for *Aesop's Fables*, which they were seeing at Circle in the Square Theatre. I created a lesson plan that included interactive exercises about Aesop, his fables, acting technique, and theatre etiquette.

• Teaching Artist at PS 166, the Richard Rodgers School of Arts & Technology; NYC, NY 2016

Circle in the Square employed me as a teaching artist to teach five different classes of kindergarteners at PS 166. I created a lesson plan that included an introduction to acting and theatre; then incorporated the story they were all reading (*The Three Billy Goats Gruff*) into acting exercises, rehearsals, and short performances.
